HALF DAY

RIDING TIME: 2.5 HOURS

EASY

Immerse Yourself in the True Essence of Patagonia on Horseback. Surrender to the timeless spirit of the gaucho and experience Patagonia in its most pristine and authentic form.

Just a scenic 30-minute journey south from Remota awaits an exclusive and unforgettable experience at a traditional Patagonian estancia, where time seems to pause and nature reigns supreme. Here, in this remote corner of the world, you will be graciously welcomed by a true gaucho, whose warmth and wisdom will open the door to the rich customs and soulful spirit of southern Patagonia.

Mounted on one of his noble horses, you will traverse awe-inspiring landscapes, from the expansive Patagonian steppe to the lush Magellanic forests, all set against the breathtaking backdrop of the majestic Última Esperanza Fjord. Each stride offers a profound connection to the untamed beauty and heritage of this extraordinary land.

At the end of the ride, and as tradition dictates, you will indulge in a traditional **mate** ceremony, Patagonia's iconic and comforting hot drink, accompanied by a local snack. A perfect way to conclude a day filled with authentic discovery and unparalleled natural splendor.

THREE CAVES ADVENTURE

DISCOVER THE LOST LEGENDS OF PATAGONIA.

HALF DAY

(I) HIKING TIME: 2.5 HOURS

DU LOW DIFFICULTY

Exploration of the Cueva del Milodón Natural Monument.

Just a few km from Remota, a site awaits that holds some of Patagonia's best-preserved secrets: the **Cueva del Milodón Natural Monument**. This group of three caves, nestled on the slopes of Cerro Benítez, holds immense geological, paleontological, and archaeological significance.

The most famous of these caverns is the **Cueva del Milodón**, where remains were found of one of the Pleistocene's most iconic inhabitants: the **milodón**, a giant herbivore that roamed this land over 10,000 years ago. But it wasn't only prehistoric animals that left their mark here, **early human traces**, considered the oldest in the region, have also been discovered, adding to the site's profound cultural and archaeological value.

As we explore the three caves, we'll witness breathtaking landscapes and connect with a natural legacy that bridges present-day Patagonia with its ancient past. It's a unique experience that invites us to imagine a time when giants—both animal and human—roamed this remote corner of the world.

BENÍTEZ LOOKOUT TREK

AN EXHILARATING ASCENT WITH PANORAMIC VIEWS OF PATAGONIA.

HALF DAY

O DURATION: 3 HOURS / 3 KM

MODERATE TO HIGH DIFFICULTY

This excursion entails a rigorous ascent along the formidable northern slope of Cerro Benítez, offering a challenging yet immensely rewarding experience. Although the incline is steep, each step brings you closer to one of the region's most breathtaking vistas: the majestic Laguna Sofía, set against the backdrop of Patagonia's untamed wilderness.

This route appeals not only to avid adventurers but also to dedicated ornithologists. Amidst the serene mountain environment, there is the opportunity to observe the sovereign of the southern skies—the magnificent Andean condor. Additionally, sightings of imposing eagles and vibrant austral parrots, among other endemic species, are common.

This is an intense and intimate encounter with nature, culminating in a visual spectacle of extraordinary beauty. It is ideally suited for those seeking a profound connection with the wild essence of Patagonia.







PETROGLYPH TREK

A JOURNEY THROUGH HISTORY, FORESTS, AND ADVENTURE.

HALF DAY

HIKING TIME: 4 HOURS / 6 KM

MODERATE DIFFICULTY

Just 30 minutes from Remota, we embark on an adventure that awakens all the senses. This trek leads us into a stunning natural setting, exploring lush lenga and coigüe forests that envelop us in their silence and freshness.

Along the way, you will uncover an invaluable legacy: the rock engravings left by the Aonikenk culture, ancient inhabitants of these lands. Their petroglyphs tell a profound story, rich in symbolism and a deep connection to nature.

The route takes us to incredible viewpoints offering panoramic vistas and, for the more daring, includes the thrill of navigating rocky passages and exploring millenary caves that seem to belong to another time.

A comprehensive experience: nature, culture, and adventure in its purest form.

Undoubtedly, one of Remota's must-see highlights.

VISIT THE CITY OF PUERTO NATALES

HALF DAY

O DURATION: 2 HOURS

LOW DIFFICULTY

To discover Puerto Natales is to understand the essence of life in the province of Última Esperanza. Walking through its streets reveals a rhythm guided by tradition, history, and the enduring warmth of its people.

This carefully curated excursion offers both a panoramic drive and a guided walking activity through this charming southern city, where understated architecture and rich local narratives evoke the legacy of early navigators, ranchers, and fishermen.

Our visit includes notable landmarks such as the Fishermen's Wharf, the County Museum, the Main SquarePlaza, and the picturesque Señoret Channel waterfront, a place where the views of fjords and mountains appear ever-changing, animated by the wind and light.

More than a city visit, this experience offers a genuine connection to the cultural fabric of Puerto Natales, its traditions, its landscape, and its people, who still preserve the serenity of a bygone era.

An ideal excursion for travelers seeking to engage with the living history of Patagonia and return with meaningful, enduring impressions.

WALK BETWEEN FJORDS: FROM PUERTO PRAT TO PUERTO CONSUELO

HALF DAY

(iii) WALKING TIME: 2 HOURS / 2 KM

LOW DIFFICULTY

Just 35 minutes north of Remota lies one of Patagonia's most serene and captivating corners: the Eberhard Fjord. This narrow arm of the sea, branching off from the majestic Última Esperanza Fjord, forms a mirror-like waterway connecting two historic ranch ports—Puerto Prat and Puerto Consuelo.

During this gentle and accessible walk, we follow in the footsteps of the region's earliest settlers. The path invites a deep appreciation of the silence of the landscape, the whisper of the Patagonian wind, and the graceful flight of native bird species that inhabit the area.

A simple yet profoundly meaningful experience — perfect for those seeking a quiet connection with local history, pristine nature, and the timeless tranquillity of an extraordinary setting.

Beyond its breathtaking vistas, this excursion offers an up-close encounter with the unique flora and fauna of the region. Expect to see guanacos, foxes, flamingos, and, if we're lucky perhaps a soaring Andean condor overhead.

MODERATE DIFFICULTY

We'll venture through two distinct sectors of the park, combining highlights from both the eastern and western regions, to offer a panoramic, in-depth view of the stunning Paine Massif. The day includes two moderate-intensity hikes, perfect for those who love to move, explore, and be awed by landscapes that feel otherworldly.

Surrounded by towering peaks, turquoise lakes, and hidden valleys, you'll also discover the park's geological history and diverse wildlife. Look out for guanacos, foxes, condors, and, if luck is on your side, even a distant glimpse of a puma in its natural habitat.

This experience is ideal for travelers seeking a more active and enriching alternative to a traditional photo safari. Here, you don't just take pictures you feel the park beneath your feet.

TREK TO BASE TORRES: CHALLENGE & REWARD

FULL DAY

(a) WALKING TIME: 9 HOURS / 24 KM.

HARD

If intense trekking is your passion and you dream of conquering one of the world's most iconic landscapes, this is the must-do you've been waiting for.

The trail to the **Base Torres Lookout** is much more than a hike: it is an epic journey that will test your endurance and reward you with a view that will truly take your breath away.

Just 1 hour and 40 minutes from Remota, this demanding route takes you through native forests, steep moraines, and ever-changing scenery that continues to surprise at every step.

During approximately 4.5 hours of steady ascent through the majestic Ascencio Valley, you'll gain elevation, excitement, and perspective until reaching 870 meters above sea level, where a turquoise glacial lake lies at the very foot of the legendary Torres del Paine.

There, where sky, rock, and effort meet, you'll understand why this trek is one of the most dreamed-of in the world of hiking.

It's tough, yes. But absolutely unforgettable.







LAZO WEBER: TRAIL OF GRAND VIEWS

A SCENIC AND SURPRISING ROUTE
TO THE HEART OF TORRES DEL PAINE.

FULL DAY

(i) HIKING TIME: 5.5 HOURS / 14 KM

MODERATE DIFFICULTY

Prepare to uncover one of the best-kept secrets of Torres del Paine National Park. Our journey begins with approximately two hours' travel to the traditional Estancia Lazo, a historic Patagonian ranch that serves as the gateway to one of the park's lesser-explored entrances... and the starting point for one of its most magical trails.

The Lazo Weber Trail is a true natural treasure. Along the route, you will be captivated by crystal-clear lagoons, native forests, winding rivers, and a variety of landscapes that change with every step. This trail is beloved not only for its breathtaking scenic beauty but also for the peace and tranquility that permeate the entire journey.

One of its greatest gifts is the panoramic view: from here, you will enjoy a privileged vantage point of the Paine Massif, crowned by a 360° viewpoint overlooking the entire national park. It is a place that invites you to pause, breathe deeply, and simply contemplate the grandeur of Patagonia.

The trail combines gentle undulating paths, vast steppe plains, and a steep moraine ascent at the end, adding a touch of adventure at just the right moment.

Undoubtedly one of the most recommended experiences during your stay at Remota, it is ideal for those seeking to connect with nature from a unique perspective and with far fewer visitors.

FRENCH VALLEY

A MYTHICAL ADVENTURE IN THE HEART OF PAINE.

FULL DAY

HIKING TIME: 8 HOURS / 20 KM.

HIGH DIFFICULTY

Prepare to conquer one of the most dreamed-of and challenging routes in Torres del Paine National Park. The French Valley is a natural spectacle that combines physical demand with landscapes so stunning they seem straight out of a postcard.

Our day begins at Remota, from where we will travel approximately two hours to the park's heart. There, we board a catamaran to navigate the turquoise waters of Lago Pehoé on a 35-minute journey to Paine Grande refuge, the starting point of this unforgettable adventure.

The trail leads us through centuries-old lenga forests, alongside the imposing Scottsberg Lake, before confronting the majesty of the French Glacier, suspended between vertical granite walls and with ice falls that echo through the valley like thunder.

This route, part of the famous "W" trek of the Paine Massif, is intense and demanding, but also one of the most rewarding. With every kilometre, you will feel the thrill of being within one of the world's most iconic places—surrounded by mountains, glaciers, and an energy only Patagonia can provide.

It is beautiful. It is challenging. It is an experience that will transform you.

BALMACEDA & SERRANO NAVIGATION

AN ADVENTURE AMONG FIORDS AND GLACIERS.

FULL DAY

8 HOURS

LOW DIFFICULTY

Embark on an unforgettable adventure through the waters of the Última Esperanza Fjord, one of Patagonia's most dazzling settings. Aboard a comfortable catamaran, we will follow the ancient routes of explorers such as Juan Ladrillero and Sarmiento de Gamboa, who navigated these waters nearly 500 years ago.

During the cruise, you will witness breathtaking landscapes, rocky outcrops teeming with wildlife, and majestic colonies of Imperial Cormorants. You will also marvel at waterfalls plunging from towering cliffs into the fjord below.

After two hours of sailing, we will arrive at Puerto Toro, the gateway to Bernardo O'Higgins National Park, the largest park in Chile. From here, we will embark on a gentle 30-minute hike through lush Magellanic Coigüe forests, culminating in a face-to-face encounter with the awe-inspiring Serrano Glacier.

On the return journey, we will make a special stop at Estancia Perales, a traditional Patagonian ranch, where a hearty, typical lunch awaits to complete this extraordinary day.

This comprehensive experience combines navigation, stunning landscapes, wildlife, history, and local gastronomy.

Come and discover the glaciers, fjords, and secrets of southern Patagonia.







GREY LAKE NAVIGATION

AN ADVENTURE TO THE HEART OF THE ICE.

FULL DAY

4 HOURS

LOW DIFFICULTY

In one of the most remote and astonishing corners of Torres del Paine National Park lies the Grey Glacier, a colossal, ancient ice mass that is part of the legendary Southern Patagonian Ice Field, the third-largest freshwater reserve on the planet.

Our journey begins with an approximately two-hour transfer from Remota to the park's western sector. After a brief check-in process, we will embark on a 40-minute walk along the shore of Grey Lake, a wild and beautiful setting that hints at the grandeur awaiting us.

Once aboard the catamaran, a three-hour navigation begins across the cold, crystalline waters of Grey Lake. From the boat, we will witness up close the glacier's imposing ice walls, admiring its three main faces and the intense color contrasts ranging from deep blue to pure white.

The Grey Glacier is not just a visual spectacle: it is an experience that connects you with the primal force of nature, the silence of eternity, and the vastness of the untouched.

CERRO CASTILLO

THE SECRET PEAK FOR ADVENTURERS.

FULL DAY

HIKING TIME: 7 HOURS / 15 KM.

HIGH DIFFICULTY

If you prefer to escape the typical routes and seek hidden treasures known to few, Cerro Castillo will captivate you. Located just outside Torres del Paine National Park, this mountain is a less crowded yet equally spectacular gem, perfect for those seeking a challenging hike with a guaranteed reward.

The adventure begins with a steep and technical ascent along the southwest slope, a climb that will make you sweat, yes... but also smile with excitement! Every step brings you closer to one of Patagonia's most breathtaking viewpoints, where everything falls into place: a 360° panorama of the entire province that leaves you speechless.

From the summit, you will see the distant Paine massif, the vast Lago del Toro, and an endless array of Patagonian terrain stretching as far as the eye can see. Here, you are far from the noise and easy paths... exactly where true adventurers find their space.

This is not for everyone, but if you seek authenticity, intensity, and unforgettable experiences, this summit is made for you.

PINGO VALLEY TREK

A HIDDEN TRAIL AMONG FORESTS AND MOUNTAINS.

FULL DAY

(iii) HIKING TIME: 5 HOURS / 10 KM.

MODERATE DIFFICULTY

Near the imposing Grey Lake lies one of the best-kept secrets of Torres del Paine National Park: the Pingo Valley Trail. This route immerses us in a landscape of dense, vibrant forests, populated by lenga, maitén, and canelo trees, where nature reveals itself in its purest form.

Our goal is to reach a lookout at the summit, from which we can enjoy a privileged view of Grey Lake and the southwest face of the majestic Paine Grande. The moderately challenging trek combines wet sections, rich vegetation-covered terrain, and the welcoming silence of a seldom-traveled environment.

Located within the National Park and approximately two hours from Remota, this trail is ideal for those seeking a more intimate, authentic experience deeply connected with nature, away from the busiest routes.

The Pingo Valley is not just a hike—it is an invitation to discover Patagonia from within, feeling the heartbeat of the forest and the energy of the mountain.







CERRO TENERIFE

HIKING TIME: 10 HOURS / 14 KM

VERY HIGH DIFFICULTY

Just 50 kilometers from Remota, overlooking the tranquil waters of Lake Porteño, stands the imposing Cerro Tenerife: a true trial by fire for high-mountain trekking enthusiasts. This is no ordinary hike, it is our most challenging excursion, specially designed for those who wish to take their adventurous spirit to the next level.

The ascent is intense and technical, featuring steep slopes and variable terrain that demand focus, endurance, and determination. The unpredictable and powerful Patagonian weather adds an extra layer of excitement and challenge. But every ounce of effort is rewarded...

At the summit, a breathtaking 360° viewpoint awaits you: a complete panorama of the province, exclusive views of small glaciers hidden near the mountain, and a sense of achievement that words cannot describe—only feel.

Cerro Tenerife is not for everyone. It is for those who dare. For those who love the mountains, challenges, and the raw, untamed majesty of Patagonia.

The challenge awaits you at the top. And the view... is worth every step.

Or, if you prefer, simply relax at the estancia, enjoy its cozy corners, and let yourself be enveloped by the tranquility of the place.

And of course... you cannot leave without trying mate, the most beloved herbal infusion of the southern world. It might surprise you at first, but by the second sip, you will feel like a true Patagonian.

BENÍTEZ VALLEY

FULL DAY

(I) HIKING TIME: 5 HOURS / 12 KM

MEDIUM DIFFICULTY

Just 30 minutes from Puerto Natales lies a seldom-explored corner that preserves the purest essence of the Patagonian landscape: Valle Benítez, a natural gem hidden in the shadow of the imposing Cerro Benítez.

This full-day hike is an invitation to disconnect from noise and reconnect with nature in its most authentic state. Along the route, we will traverse nearly untouched Magellanic forests, walk alongside the little-known vega of Cerro Benítez—a true wildlife oasis—and feel the surroundings grow wilder and freer with every step.

But the highlight comes at the end: a breathtaking viewpoint, perched between rocks and wind, will reward us with awe-inspiring vistas. And if luck is on our side, as it often is , we will witness the majestic flight of the Andean condor, soaring the sky with its vast wings, nesting in the high overhangs of the mountain as the true guardians of the valley.
